Allora Quartet

Formed in 2020, the Allora Quartet is made up of four exciting young musicians from Cork. Megan, Michelle, Stephen and Michael Murphy are previous students of the MTU Cork School of Music.

Aradia Quartet

Aradia Quartet was founded in 2021 with members from three Irish counties. Members are currently studying both at home and abroad and some are making a return visit to the West Cork Chamber Music Festival.

Leggiadro Quartet

Three members of Leggiadro Quartet - violinist Shane Quinn, violist Kevin O'Loughlin and cellist Catherine Cotter - currently study at the Royal Irish Academy of Music while violinist Julieanne Forrest studies at MUK Vienna. Julieanne has also had solo debut with the RTÉ Concert Orchestra and at Carnegie Hall.

Hill Quartet

Hill Quartet is an innovative, multi-national chamber ensemble based in London. With strong roots in the classical world, the musicians hold a deep interest in expanding the string quartet repertoire by curating, commissioning and performing cross-genre art forms and contemporary music.

The Omnis Quartet met in September 2021 when they began studying at the Royal Irish Academy of Music. They share a love of exploring all styles of music, performing music by the great string quartet masters such as Haydn and Beethoven, paired with a range of styles of contemporary and folk music.

We are delighted to be back with our Fringe Festival exploring some beautiful spots around West Cork.

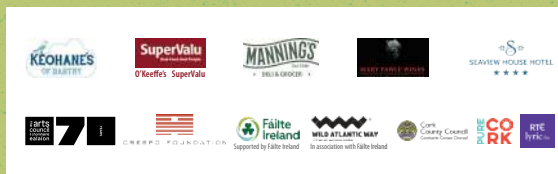
