Aradia Quartet Playing together since 2020, Aradia are delighted to be returning to West Cork Chamber Music Festival for the second year in a row. They were the 2022 fellowship quartet at Concorda Chamber Music Course.

Calathea Quartet Comprised of musicians from New Zealand, Australia, Ireland, and England. Formed in 2020 at the Royal Academy of Music. They are currently based in London and are Britten-Pears Young Artists 2022/23.

Inis Quartet An exciting new ensemble currently preparing for a concert tour this August. Their repertoire at the moment is comprised of works by Ravel, Mozart, Shostakovich and Fanny Mendelssohn, among others.

Lanuarua Quartet The members of this dynamic young string quartet are based in Cork, Dublin and London. Their beautiful programme features Mozart String Quartet No. 22 in B flat major KV. 589 and Schumann Quartet Op. 41 No. 1 in A minor.

Omnis Quartet Formed in 2021 when studying at the Royal Irish Academy of Music, Omnis share a love of exploring all styles of music, performing music by the great string quartet masters such as Haydn and Beethoven and a range of styles of contemporary and folk music.

Tiffin Boys' Choir Since its foundation in 1957, Tiffin Boys' Choir has worked extensively with the world's greatest conductors, performed for the world's best musical institutions, and recorded with the world's leading musical ensembles. The choir has worked with all the London orchestras and performs regularly with Royal Opera.

Treske Quartet Founded in Manchester in 2017, the quartet is currently pursuing the RNCM String Quartet Studio programme and Chamber Studio in King's Place, London. The quartet are the 'Young Artists 2022' at the Kensington Olympia Festival of Music and the Arts.

Westland Baroque Comprising of students or recent graduates of the Royal Irish Academy of Music in Dublin. All members have a particular passion for Baroque music and enjoy exploring unique repertoire under the expert mentorship of Professor David Adams.

There will also be surprise pop-ups around Bantry so keep your eyes open and follow your ears!

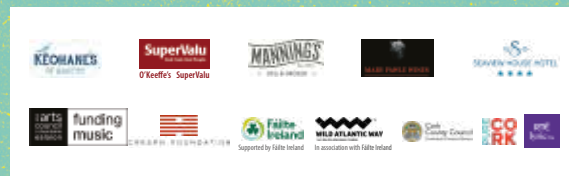
