

ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

As well as this exciting Fringe programme, there are many more concerts and events happening in Bantry.

COFFEE CONCERTS This popular series takes place every morning at 11am in St Brendan's Church. Pop into the marquee for coffee, cake and chat before the concert and enjoy some of the most beloved music in the classical repertoire, from Beethoven and Bach to Handel and Haydn.

12.30 CRESPO SERIES This series is a chance to listen to some of the lesser known works of chamber and solo music. These concerts are less than an hour, but is music for listeners who like to wander off the beaten track, in the lovely Marino Church, the latest addition to the Festival concert venues.

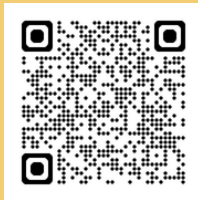
YOUNG MUSICIANS SERIES Featuring the ensembles participating in the Masterclass Programme, this series takes place most afternoons at 2pm. Lasting only an hour, it is the perfect concert for young people.

4PM CRESPO SERIES These hour-long concerts take place daily. If you can't quite squeeze in a full two-hour concert, then here is the chance to listen to world class musicians perform in the marvellous surroundings of Bantry House or St Brendan's Church.

MAIN EVENING CONCERTS The centrepiece of every day at the Festival. These concerts last two hours at Bantry House or St Brendan's Church, and feature multiple musicians and groups in each concert. The concert atmosphere is wonderful, and with an interval and bar, audiences can get the full concert experience.

CANDLELIT LATE NIGHTS A much-loved series, these late concerts, lasting less than an hour, are a perfect close to the day. With the venues lit by candles and the sun setting, it's chamber music as it's truly meant to be heard.

IBO Young Artists

The IBO Apprentice Programme is the first of its kind in Ireland, offering an intensive high-level professional development opportunity to Ireland's most talented young professionals.

Meliora Quartet

The name "Meliora" comes from the Latin word for "improvement", an idea that lies at the heart of the quartet's identity. Stemming from this concept, they greatly enjoys playing and sharing music they have explored together.

Olympia Quartet

Whether performing well-known chamber music works or exploring new compositions, the Olympia Quartet strive to make meaningful connections with their audience through music and showcasing their joy of playing together.

Talland Quartet

The Talland Quartet formed during their time at the Royal Northern College of Music and are dedicated to sharing their passion for chamber music with others. They are keen to support the creation of new music and are currently working on a commission with composer Eden Longson.

Tara Quartet

Formed in September 2025 in Dublin, the Tara Quartet is based at the Royal Irish Academy of Music. Since its formation, the ensemble has been dedicated to developing a strong and unified artistic identity, with a particular focus on the core string quartet repertoire.
